LAS VEGAS (June 28, 2019) – The PENTA Building Group's (PENTA) charitable arm, The PENTA CARES Foundation, raised \$150,000 for three Southern Nevada nonprofits during its recent 15th Annual Charity Golf Classic at the Revere Golf Club. NCCF, founded in 1993, offers more than 40 programs and services for critically ill children and their families living in Southern Nevada. The donation from PENTA will benefit Project A.R.K. (aids and resources for kids), which encompasses all of the social, financial, emotional and psychological needs for families who have a child diagnosed with cancer and many other life-threatening illnesses.

"On behalf of the Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation and all the children and families that we serve, we are so grateful once again to The PENTA Building Group for including us as one of the charities in another incredibly successful golf tournament," said NCCF President and CEO Jeff Gordon. "To all the golfers and companies who support this wonderful day of TRIUMPH on the golf course, our gratitude knows no limits. All those who participated have made such an impact on so many in our community who need our help – these dollars go to a very noble and loving cause."

WDC works to develop and provide affordable housing, economic and educational opportunities and support services to families and individuals. The donation from PENTA will benefit the nonprofit's Transitional Housing Program, which helps single men or women with dependent children who are homeless due to loss of job, falling ill, domestic violence, fleeing an abuser, etc. The program provides vital support to families while looking for employment.

"This donation will make such a difference in the lives of our clients who would otherwise be on the street, sleeping in a car, park or bathroom of a hotel," said WDC Executive Director Tina Prieto. "The Women's Development Center is honored to be a part of

PENTA's annual golf tournament and are so grateful to all who attend and make this donation possible."

Serving Nevada's men and women in the armed services, veterans and their families, the NMSA works to organize and promote the recognition, support and appreciation for those in the armed forces. In partnership with Homes for our Troops, NMSA will use the funds to build its third adaptive home for a catastrophically injured Nevada veteran Army Sergeant Adam Poppenhouse. He lost both of legs in an IED explosion in Iraq while serving as a tanker in the 3rd Stryker Brigade. He and his wife Megan have two young children.

"We at the Nevada Military Support Alliance are humbled by the support the PENTA team has given Nevada's military members, veterans and their families," said NMSA President Scott Bensing. "This year's gift from PENTA will go toward our commitment to build an adaptive home for a U.S. Army Sergeant and his family in the Las Vegas Valley. PENTA will make a direct and immediate impact in the life of this Nevada family, as it has done with so many other warriors by generously supporting our mission."
